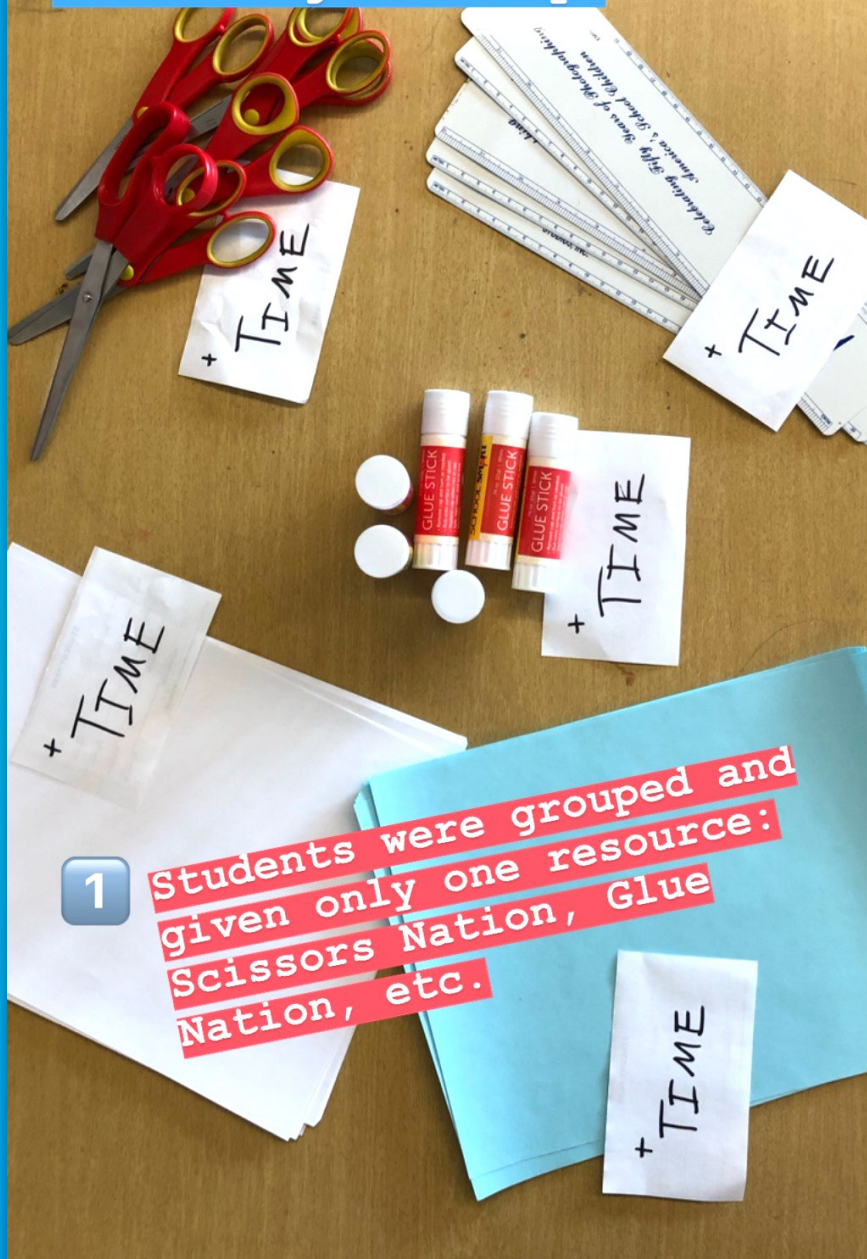

BY MAKING PAPER CHAINS



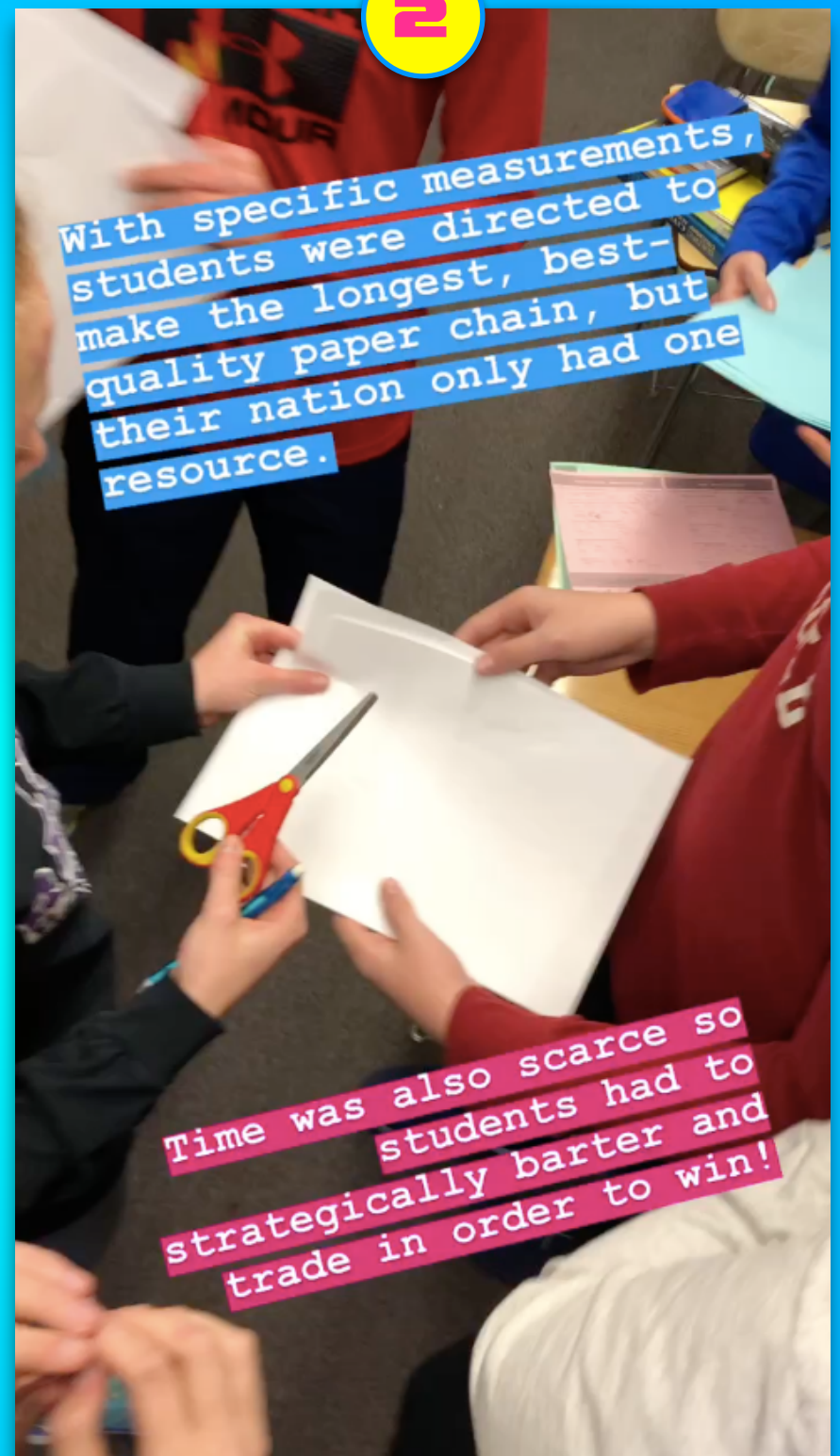

With specific measurements, students were directed to make the longest, best-quality paper chain, but their nation only had one resource.

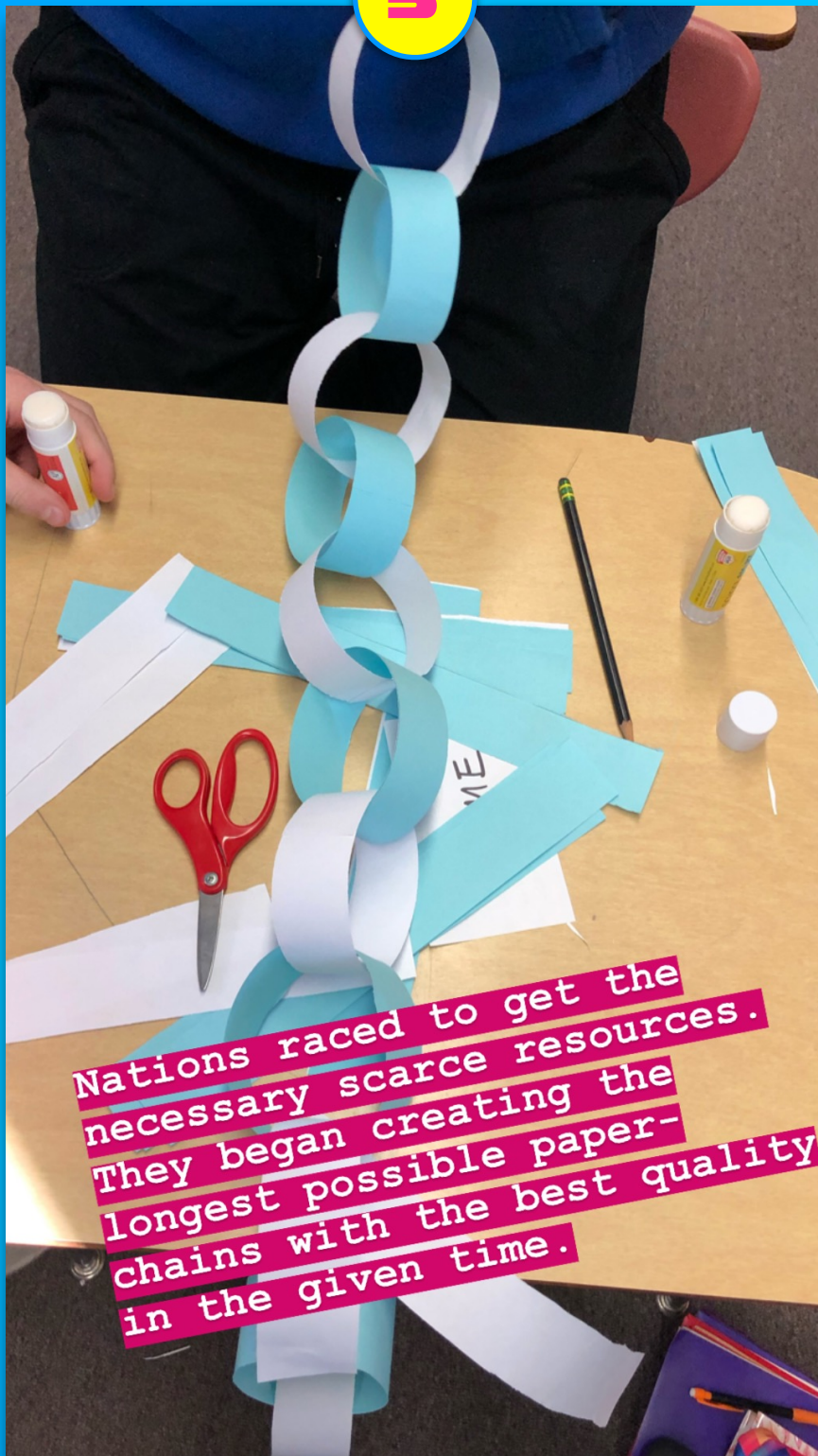

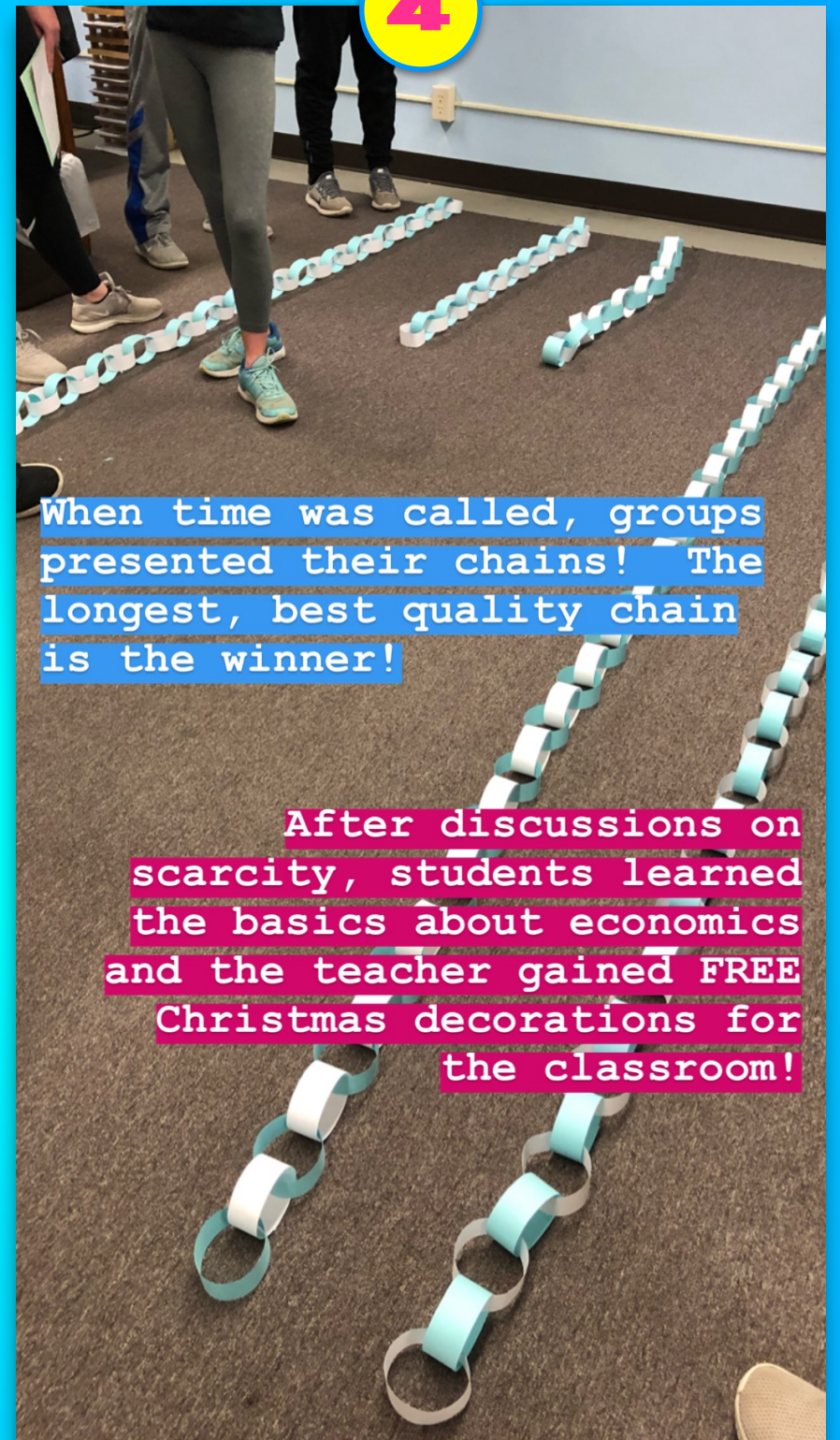
